From the Director

We are now well in to Lent due to an early Easter. I read recently that there is talk of fixing Easter to be the same weekend every year. Having a variable feast dependent on when the first full moon is after 21st March does sometimes have complications. And of course, some Eastern European churches have a different day anyway! So we had our first service after one week of rehearsals and were already in Lent. This year we have sung a plainsong mass setting during Lent, the *Missa de Angelis*. A unison setting has been useful as 50% of our bass section are out of Sydney for some services.

We will sing the Crucifixion on Good Friday at St John's, Gordon as usual. We are fortunate to have the same soloists as last year, Craig Everingham (Baritone) and Damian Arnold (Tenor) and are looking forward to working with them again. After that we have out annual trip to Bowral. We will be singing Vigil Mass twice at St Mary's Cathedral in 2016, so it is a busy year, as usual.

We have a few new singers which is encouraging and they are getting used to the quirks of the choir and the large turnover of music. As always, we are keen to sign up new singers as regulars or deputies.

I was given a book on hymn tunes for Christmas. It was very interesting to see that places where some hymn tunes are named. For instance, did you know that the tune Crimond (The Lord's my shepherd) comes from a village in Scotland where the church clock has 61 minutes on the face?

I hope you will be able to join us at some services and especially on Good Friday.

We will as usual be singing Stainer's Crucifixion on Good Friday. This has become a tradition that we really look forward to. More details elsewhere. After Easter, we have a lull until Anzac week, when we take part in 2 ceremonies.

We have been invited by West Pymble Chamber of Commerce to sing WW1 soldiers songs before joining in their ceremony at 11am, remembering the Centenary of the Anzac landing, when we will change to songs and hymns of a more solemn nature. We are looking forward to this interesting event.
